3.1 CEO Report

CEO Bill Kostandas sent his report out via email. Discussion as follows:

- Spartan Agreement legal document, Nicki Bowman spoke about legalities and the need to have both parties agree to accurately capture the agreement.

3.4 IRFA Report

Paul Herbert spoke about the Football NSW Referees Review, still no decision on Trust funds, holding \$250,000. Season in Review

- Referees 65% are under 23, good for future.
- 4 members to State
- Numbers of female referees growing
- 2 referees on AR Refs Panel
- Delfina Dimoski on FFA Refs Panel
- Referees would like some administration assistance for a fee, more discussion needed.
- AGM in two weeks' time, 3 year rotation is in place so only some replacements needed.

3.5 Life Membership

FSC Chairman Eddy De Gabriele presented a draft of the FSC Life Membership document. Eddy spoke about the philosophy and the strategies presented in his paper. Eddy also spoke about the intent of Life Membership and having the balance right.

<u>Action</u>; Directors are to provide comments to Eddy as soon as possible. Claude Cuda suggested that after the Final Draft has FSC Board Agreement then the paper should be sent out to councils for consultation and Final Agreement. General agreement is that paper should be circulated to Councils for discussion and agreement.

3.7 Football Councils Update

- Futsal Football Council Rosemary Digger
 Season began October 6th with Taipans playing Sutherland.
 FFA has declared that each State may enter one team in each age group to compete in National Championships in January in Canberra. Question is what will happen to Southern NSW including Athletes with Disabilities? Pathway for Illawarra players doesn't look promising. Rosemary Digger is to further pursue clarification and report to Board.
- Juniors Football Council no report available.
- Men's Football Council Claude Cuda
 Grand Final had new format which was very successful. Friday night Grand Final had approx. 570 spectators. Presentation Night will be on Friday 26 October.
 - Applications are open for Men's Premiership League and a Competition Questionnaire has been distributed to gain feedback for possible changes in Season 2014.
- Women's Football Council Sandy Depers presented her paper which contained lots of good news from the season. Nicki Bowman reported that she would be attending the Season Launch for the Women's League in Sydney and that the Australian Federal Police sponsor Canberra W League. Government agencies are able to provide sponsorships!

 Nicki Bowman reported having the opportunity to have an individual meeting with Frank Lowy. Discussion ranged over a variety of topics including the structure of FSC and the progress of Unification.
